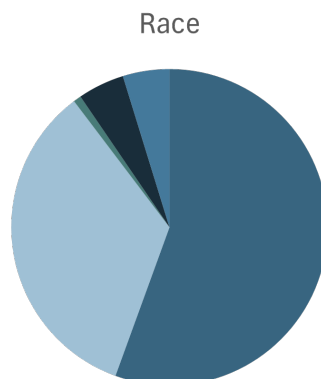
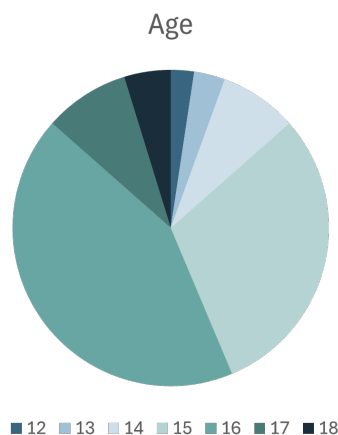
2024 ANNUAL REPORT



Mansfield Juvenile Treatment Center is a secure residential program serving male youth ages 11 to 18 who present with moderate to high-risk behaviors, including aggression, behavioral challenges, and sexually harmful behaviors. The program follows an academy model that encourages diverse social and educational engagement, supporting the development of essential life competencies.

Youth at Mansfield receive comprehensive therapeutic and academic services, along with evidence-based group interventions. These include Positive Skill Development (PSD), Positive Organizational Culture (POC), Seeking Safety, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), Thinking for a Change (T4C), and character skill development sessions.

2024 OUTCOMES

- 16 years old was the average age in 2024
- 88% of discharges were successful exits
- 8 High School diplomas and 10 GEDs awarded
- 100% compliance with student IEPs
- 2.0 grade equivalent growth in reading
- 1.9 grade equivalent growth in math
